Please join us for an engaging discussion and "call to action" featuring healthcare industry leaders from both NAHSE and Deloitte specializing in health inequities, community health, and vaccine development.

While citizens and governments celebrate the arrival of a vaccine against COVID-19, the reality is that the pandemic is not over – rather, the next phase begins, with new challenges related to vaccine distribution. COVID-19 has had an outsized impact on under-represented minority communities, especially Black Americans, amplifying pre-existing disparities in workplace safety, health, and access to care. How can the US ensure that vaccine distribution works to remedy these disparities, rather than exacerbate them?

National, local, and healthcare industry leaders will need to balance challenges related to supply chain limitations, cost, and equity, while fighting against potential cultural headwinds related to mistrust of both the vaccine and the healthcare system distributing it. This session seeks to explore the shape of the challenges to come and generate potential approaches from the individual to the institutional.
